## COLORADO KAIROS HISTORY

1982 God led Bill Potter and the St Francis Episcopal Cursillo Ultreya group in Colorado Springs to pray about starting a prison ministry in Colorado. DOC pointed Bill toward CWCF, which put Bill in touch with a CWCF lay volunteer named Bill Fay, who had been praying since January for someone with the organizational skills to launch a "Cursillo" program in the Colorado prisons. The two Bills connected. Bill Potter already knew about Kairos, so he then connected with Kairos National in Florida and observed a Kairos there.
