SPIRITUALLY SPEAKING:

LISTENING-AN ATTIRBUTE OF GOD

IN EXODUS 2:24 & 25, WE READ: "AND GOD HEARD THEIR GROANING, AND GOD REMEMBERED HIS COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM, WITH ISAAC, AND WITH JACOB. AND GOD SAW THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL AND GOD KNEW THEIR CONDITION."

GOD ACTUALLY HEARS. GOD ACTUALLY IS LISTENING. GOD ACTUALLY IS CONCERNED. GOD ACTUALLY KNOWS WHAT'S GOING ON. WHEN YOU READ OF ISRAEL AND THE EXODUS, YOU READ ABOUT A PEOPLE THAT MOANED AND GROANED. DESPITE WHAT MAY BE CONSIDERED COMPLAINING, OR AS THE SCRIPTURES SAY "GROANING", GOD CARED.

LET US LOOK AT IMPLICATIONS OF A LISTENING GOD.

- 1. GOD HAS TIME FOR US. IN THE BUSY SOCIETY IN WHICH WE LIVE WE HAVE NO TIME FOR ONE ANOTHER. WE ARE CAUGHT UP IN THIS IMMEDIATE GRATIFICATION, INSTANT FOOD, QUICK FIXES, AND ON IT GOES. JESUS SAID "COME UNTO ME ALL YOU WHO LABOR AND ARE HEAVY LADEN,..." HE HAS TIME FOR US.
- 2. GOD HAS A CONCERN FOR US. PETER WROTE TO THE SCATTERED CHURCH IN ASIA MINOR THESE WORDS, "CASTING ALL YOUR CARE UPON HIM; FOR HE CARETH FOR YOU." NO MATTER WHAT THE CARE MAY BE, NO MATTER WHAT THE BURDEN, CAST IT ON GOD. HE IS CONCERNED ABOUT YOU.
- 3. HE KNOWS WE ARE IMPORTANT. PAUL TELLS US, "GOD COMMENDED HIS LOVE TOWARD US, IN THAT WHILE WE WERE YET SINNERS, CHRIST DIED FOR US." WE MATTER, WE COUNT IN GOD EYES. IF HE TAKES CARE OF THE SPARROWS, AND THE LILIES OF THE FIELD, WILL HE NOT ALSO TAKE CARE OF US. WHY? WE ARE IMPORTANT TO HIM.
- 4. GOD IS AVAILABLE TO US. DAVID, IN THE 145TH PSALM HAS SAID, "THE LORD IS NIGH UNTO ALL THEM THAT CALL UPON HIM, TO ALL THAT CALL UPON HIM IN TRUTH." CALL AND HE IS THERE WAITING TO HEAR FROM US.
- 5. GOD SEES VALUE IN US. IN THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT JESUS TALKS ABOUT CLOTHING THE GRASS OF THE FIELD. THEN HE ASKS THE QUESTION, ", SHALL HE NOT MUCH MORE CLOTHE YOU, OH YE OF LITTLE FAITH?" JESUS REPLY TO THAT QUESTION IS "SURE HE WILL." AGAIN, WHY? GOD SEES VALUE IN US.
- 6. GOD KNOWS OUR SITUATION. AS THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL WERE MAKING THEIR JOURNEY THROUGH THE WILDERNESS, IT BECAME NECESSARY TO BE GUIDED. WHAT DID GOD DO? HE PROVIDED THE PILLAR OF CLOUD BY DAY AND FIRE BY NIGHT. WE LATER READ, "HE TOOK NOT AWAY THE PILLAR OF THE CLOUD BY DAY, NOR THE PILLAR OF FIRE BY NIGHT, FROM BEFORE THE PEOPLE." Three men visited the May Secretariat meeting to present the NATIONAL PRISON INVASION which will take place on Dec 5, 6 & 7, 1986 in 850 prisons throughout the country. In Colorado this program will only be allowed in County Jails, Buena Vista, Rifle, and Excelsor. It's nice to serve the Lord on a KAIROS weekend. The spiritual uplift does us all a lot of good. I know in my own case, sometimes I feel I have made my weekend all over again. If spiritual highs were measured in money I know I could not afford to pay for the blessings I received.

That brings me to my next point and that is the cost of a weekend. cost is about \$100 per candidate, yet cost to a team member is \$50? I am told by the Treasurer that the funds paid out for the cost of a weekend (per team member) far exceeds the funds paid in by the team members. It sometimes is a drain on our budgets to pay for OUR expense of the weekend.

I am not by any means saying if you can't pay, don't serve. I am saying there are many ways to accomplish the same means: 1) Pay your \$50 all at once if you can or 2) by small payments at each team meeting, 3) by a donation from your church; 4) have your Reunion Group (or ?) sponsor you or a candidate; 5) get donations from civic or trade groups; 6) other ideas you may have to raise money. (Please share with us YOUR ideas and SEE ARTICLE BELOW.)

There are several husbands and wives who both serve. That could be many as 6 weekends a year -- that's quite a drain on the budget and time, for which KAIROS is grateful. Folks, it still comes down to the bottom line: we are committed to KAIROS let's be committed all the way!

WHY KAIROS?

(Greek for "God's Special Time") is a trans-denominational Christian prison ministry which has proven to be uniquely successful in truly changing lives behind bars and "on the street". Starting with a 3-day encounter with Jesus Christ through the loving community of team members, continues with Christian peer group support within the facility, and loving support by the outside community through retreats and monthly gatherings of and outside team members. The weekend itself is a short course in Christianity consisting of talks, meditations, small group sharing, worship, music, home-cooked meals and LOVE -- lots of AGAPE LOVE. The team doesn't just talk about God's love, they LIVE it throughout the weekend.

this comes about by God's grace through the willing sacrifices of Talent and Treasure by many dedicated team members, and the support of many who cannot serve on teams but who bake cookies, prepare meals, attend the Closings, send "love gifts" (Palanca), and PRAY. Such help is vital to the ministry. The depth of inmate response to KAIROS is difficult to convey but here are samples: "I was lost... without hope... no guide, no friend... I have found the path to freedom, hope with vision... I found Jesus Christ!"

A KAIROS COSTS AT LEAST \$100 PER INMATE PER WEEKEND: housing teams near Canon City, food for all, supplies, backup overhead such as postage and long distance calls, etc. Team members are asked to give, besides Time and Talent, \$50 Treasure each time they serve. God provides the rest, of course, but He provides it through US - His people. A handful of our faithful have pledged a regular monthly amount, whether on a current team or not. Those steady gifts, whatever size, do accumulate and are most helpful. We have even had two donations come recently from inmates! What a precious expression of generosity and God's love THAT is!. Please pray about how YOU can be God's agent meeting our needs. TAKE THIS PLEA TO: your Pastors, church boards, outreach and social concerns committees, women's and men's and youth groups, civic groups, employers, businesses. All gifts are tax deductible, receipts sent annually.
