ONE YEAR AT A TIME

The Kairos Board of Directors extends its deepest gratitude to Donna Bolte and Al Rodriguez who have just retired after several years of dedicated service on the Board. For the past year Donna served as President and Al as Vice President/Chief-of-Operations. Thank you!

At the Annual Meeting in January, the 1989 Board elected four new members to three-year terms. They are the Rev Dave Buckingham, Konnie Kindle, Collin St Clair, and Pete Tomashek. We congratulate them and welcome them to their new areas of service.

At its February meeting, the new Board elected officers for 1990: President Art Wise, Vice President/Chief-of-Operations Ed Junghans, Secretary Gerry Lam, and Treasurer Jim Waters. The complete list of the Board of Directors and their responsibilities is on the back page.

John Keiser has been appointed as Facility Coordinator for Territorial. He has been serving as Properties Director. We now need someone to take on the responsibility for the Properties. We store furniture inside the prisons, but we have a storage trailer, parked in Canon City, for portable and consumable items that need to be stored and inventoried between Weekends and Retreats. So we pray that someone will take on the Properties job soon. Is Christ calling YOU to this service?

Fr Dave Jones is temporarily coordinating for Fremont. Art Wise will appoint (and the Board will confirm) someone to assume that position after Fremont #15 in March. Each Facility Coordinator works closely with the Chaplain in making arrangements for all Kairos activities in the consistency of the

SPIRITUALLY SPEAKING ---- ABOUT SMALL GROUPS

"For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another." (1 John 3:11)

"In the presence of Mary, Martha and Lazarus, Jesus experienced the kind of accepting, sustaining friendship he rarely found upon the road. CALENDAR NOTES

The schedule for the 1990 Kairos 3-day Weekends is listed below. The Kairos program also includes Instructional Ultreyas, 2-day Retreats, and monthly Ultreyas (in-prison reunions of inmates and outside team members). Most important are the regular meetings, in prison and out, of the small "Share and Prayer Groups". (Jesus Himself had a small group -- Peter, James, and John. He also had the agape fellowship of His friends in Bethany - see above).

Each 3-day Weekend is preceded by eight community-formation team meetings, usually held over a period of about two months. Each 3-day Weekend is followed by an Instructional Ultreya within two weeks and a 2-day Retreat within 3 months. The smaller teams for the follow-ups are usually drawn from members of the team of that particular Weekend. All team members are committed to participating in at least half of the monthly Ultreyas for one year after serving on a Weekend team. This follow-up commitment is vital to our demonstration of God's continuing love through us for the inmates.

Still another tool for demonstrating God's love through His people is the attendance of a good number of outside visitors at each Weekend's Closing on Sunday evening. The Closing gives the inmates a chance to share what the Weekend has meant to them with those outsiders who prayed and baked cookies for them. Attendance at Closing requires forms and/or lists, depending on which facility, about one month ahead of time. Please be sure to contact a team member or the person listed below.

PROGRESS REPORT: CHAPEL at COLORADO WOMEN'S CORRECTIONAL FACILITY

>>>>>>> FEBRUARY 1990: \$7,500 TO GO JULY 1988: COST #32,500

The Kairos Prison Chapel Fund drive was star ted almost two years ago in order to provide a "home" for the religious activities in CWCF. During extensive remodeling started mid-1987, spaces disappeared which had been available for major programs such as Kairos Weekends and Restreats and Prison Fellowship Seminars. Those programs were put on indefirite hold, since the remodeling plans did not include any such space in the future. State funds cannot be spent for religious program space in prisons.

Thanks to \$9,000 in donations and a \$23,500 no-interest loan from St John Chrysostom Charitable Trust, we successfully placed a modular Chapel building on the grounds of CWCF in July 1988. Since then, that Chapel has been "home" for regular Sunday services, Chaplain's offices, some weekday classes, 4 Kairos Weekends, 4 Kairos Retreats, and 2 Prison Fellowship Seminars.

Since July 1988, donations have reduced the balance due on the no-interest loan to \$7,500. Thanks be to God for His generous people! But we're not done yet, and YOU are the WE who will complete this project and GIVE the remaining \$7,500 needed to retire the loan. Please pray about your own tax-deductible response, and tell your churches and friends about this need, too.
