
KAIROS LOGO LAPEL PINS

KAIROS MEN NEEDED FOR LIMON

As announced in the last Newsletter, Kairos has started at the Limon Correctional Facility, which is three miles south of Limon. Our initial program consists of Monthly Reunions on the third Sundays of the month from 1:30 to 4:00 (team meets at gate at 1:00). Limon Kairos #1 can be organized only when some 30 men have stepped forward and committed to it and to the monthly reunions that will follow. To date, eight men have volunteered (Thank you, Lord!) and there have been five or six at each of the three reunions held to date. We also need someone to volunteer to be the Limon Coordinator, at least long enough to get things going. Meanwhile, Jim Saunders (Denver dialing area 794-3623) has volunteered to be the interim contact for the Limon clearance forms. Please pray for God's leading as we move at His pace into this new area.

---- FROM WOMEN'S KAIROS #20 CLOSING ----

Coming to prison was so hard — like I was buried in the grave. I was weak and someone out there was praying for me. Then He rose and brought me out of the grave with Him.

I was a Satan worshipper when I came in, but I found God and I'm going to be baptized.

I took my bag of Forgiveness Cookies to an officer. I asked them to forgive all of us in green for just seeing the blue uniforms and not the people inside of them.

I didn't think nobody loved me. For the first time in my life I feel I'm loved.

I was skeptical. I had not been attending church, for 101 reasons, like "all those hypocrits". Then I learned that church is <u>for</u> hypocrits.

We may not always get the forgiveness we want from people, but we always get it from God.

I started two other Kairos weekends. I ran from them screaming and kicking. I didn't know how to accept love. Then I developed a relationship with Jesus and this time He helped me complete it.

I've had a burden since I was 9 years old, but I saw Jesus yesterday and now that burden has been lifted.

I was looking for love in all the wrong places. I found out how to love myself.

Your prayers worked -- Close security people got to come. God decided that. Barriers were broken down by the people God made. No matter what happens, God and Jesus are backing me. It still hurts, but He takes away my sins.

I am taking with me me the strength to walk, to walk in joy.

I forgave the person that I couldn't forgive since I was 8 years old. and today I can look them in the face and tell them I love them.

When I came I was emotionally drained. I didn't think coming would make any difference, but it did. No matter what, I'm going to make it because God is there. I can be me and everyone will accept me for who I am. I felt love that doesn't end.

I'm so glad I found God in time!

PLEASE WRITE THE PURPOSE OF YOUR DONATION ON YOUR CHECK OR IN AN ATTACHED NOTE!

For some time now our Treasurer, with the help of facility coordinators and Rectors, has been posting expense and income actions by facility. This is to help with cash flow decisions and to foster a sense of fairness among the facility teams who are conscientious about raising enough funds to cover their weekend and retreat expenses. Soon each facility Advisory Council will be doing its own detailed bookkeeping, with the District (Board) Treasurer being responsible only for the total dollars raised and the total dollars spent.
