THE AGE OF ROCKS-OR-THE ROCK OF AGES?

I hear so many things about the age of God's creation, Of how old someone thinks it is in their mind of speculation. Someone found a piece of wood, petrified by time,
And though it's just a rock to me,
it's now a scientific find! Thus it makes the headlines of some paper in the land And people flock to see it and touch it with their hand. People actually pay to see some fossil that's been found And listen to a lecture on how long it's been around. Though I have no knowledge of how old something may be, I find myself much more concerned with Who created all we see. Tis' God who fills my very life and in Who grace I stand. Tis' He created everything we find upon this land. No, it's not the "age of rocks" I ponder in my mind, Tis' in the Rock of Ages, where true happiness I find.

A new Colorado Department of Corrections program isn't meant to be a pleasant experience for the youthful female offenders it targets. And it isn't.

The program started in March 1991 and is patterned after a program for male juvenile offecders. The youthful offenders, from all over the state, are taught lessons by older convicts who learned them the hard way.

Inmates Michelle Sykes and Mary Fernandez, (Kairos participants), warned the girls who visited recently about some of the harsh realities they would face in CWCF.

Mary pointed to the cells reserved for new arrivals and said, "Your home is in that cage where you are in a double-bunked room and locked up for 23 hours a day until they place you in a living unit."

The girls were warned that other prisoners will try to sneak cigarettes or pop to the newcomers, making them think they are friends. But, "What they really are doing is checking you out... You will have to pay up for getting those smokes or that pop."... in ways the girls may find devastating.

The program works, according to volunteers from Colorado Springs who run it.
